#### TRANSPORTATION SERVICE AGREEMENT 2016-2017

No discounts are available for multiple children in a family. All charges will be billed by Lancaster Country Day School and will be shown on your statement.

LCDS will contract for transportation for this service. Such company will be expected to provide vehicles and operators and insurance provisions that meet all local, state and federal regulations governing transportation of elementary and secondary school students.

### STUDENT/PARENT PLEDGE

# To Keep My Bus Riding Privileges - I Will Follow These Simple Rules:

I will behave on the bus exactly as I would behave in my classroom at school.

I will be courteous and respectful to my fellow riders, to the bus driver, and to any parents or teachers riding the bus. The language I use will be the same as if I was talking to my parents or teachers.

I will not tease or bully. If I am bullied, I will ask for the bullying to stop. If the bully does not stop, I will report this to the bus driver. If I see others being bullied, I will ask the bully to stop or report this to the bus driver.

I will do my part to keep the bus clean. If I make a mess I will clean it up. I will not eat or drink on the bus.

I will obey when the bus driver asks me to sit down, to change my behavior, or to change my seat on the bus.

I will not use tobacco, alcohol or any controlled substance on the bus or at the bus stops.

I will not do anything to damage the bus. If I do something to accidentally damage the bus, I will report it to the bus driver.

I will stay in my assigned seat on the bus unless the bus driver asks me to move, or gives me permission to change seats.

I will keep all of me inside the bus - head, hands, feet and possessions - and will not throw anything from the bus.

I know that school rules begin when I get on the bus, and ends only when I leave the bus in the afternoon.

The School and the bus drivers have the authority to give a warning slip. If I receive a warning slip, I will give it to my parents for their signature and return it to the bus driver and the School. I realize that serious or repeated minor violations of the rules will result in my being unable to ride the bus for a certain number of days. In addition, repeated offenses may result in my permanent removal from the bus.
