



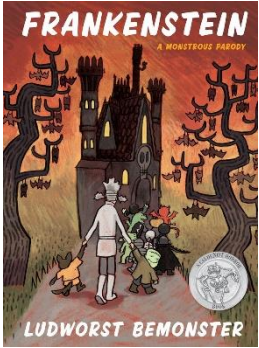

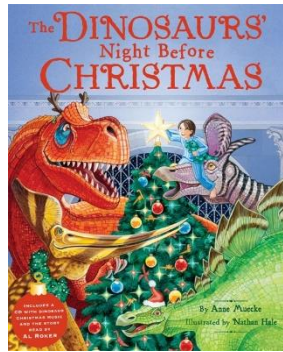


Frankenstein: A Monstrous Parody

This laugh-out-loud funny and devilish tale is a picture-book send-up of Ludwig Bemelmans's classic *Madeline* with a Halloween twist.



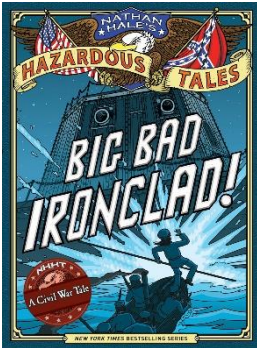
The Dinosaurs' Night Before Christmas; w/CD

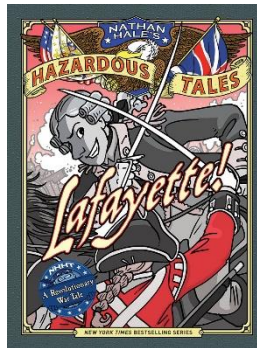
Big Bad Ironclad!

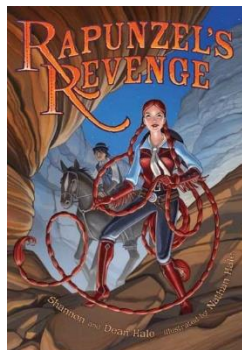

with authors Shannon and Dean Hale

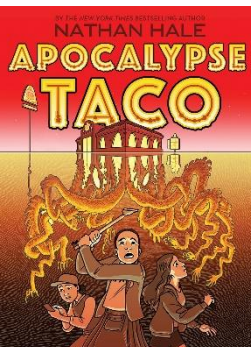
