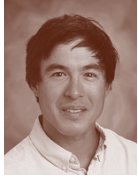

### Soccer Workshop

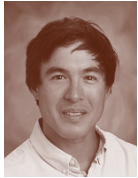

### Advanced Soccer Preparation

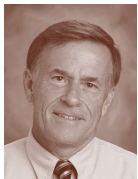
