**Clothing:** Quick-dry shirts and shorts are recommended. Shoes that can get wet and stay on your feet. Everyone must wear shoes. Light wool socks will add warmth. For **girls**, one-piece bathing suits are permitted. Two-piece bikini suits are not permitted. Again, quick drying clothing to wear over the swim suit is recommended. For **boys**, quick drying shorts and shirts are recommended. Non-bikini style swimming trunks are acceptable. **DO NOT WEAR COTTON.** Do bring a change of clothing for after the trip.

Other items to bring: A packed lunch in a sealable bag (eaten during a break on the river). Money for dinner stop on our way back. Personal snacks for the bus ride (energy bars, fruit, etc...). Some snacks available on bus. Sunscreen. Sunglasses and/or hat.
